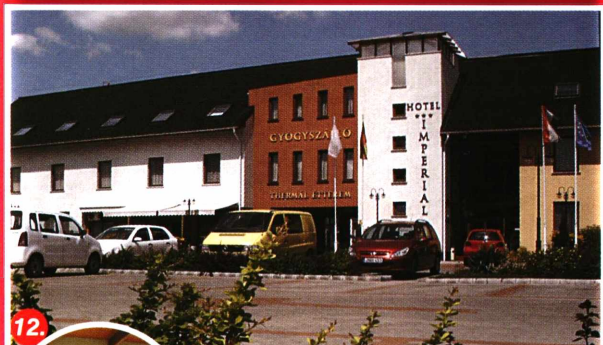

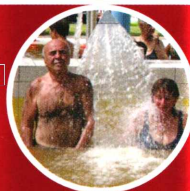

There is a large swimming pool a children's pool, and there are two covered fun pool with medicinal waters on the territory of lido. One of the most advantageous composition medicinal waters of Europa can be found here, which is 53 Celsius/127,4 F. This thermal water is eminently suitable for alleviation of urological, gynaecological and locomotor disease complaints. The shady campsite that is right beside of the pools has place for more than 50 tents or motor caravans with the availability of cooking and electric current.

The christening carafe, which were used for Petőfi's christening is being held in the front room of the house.

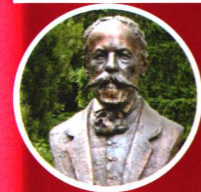
The bronze statue of Petőfi Sándor was dedicated on the Main Square in 1927.

A permanent exhibition can be visited in the museum about the history and the origin of the town. Periodical exhibitions are held in the small gallery.

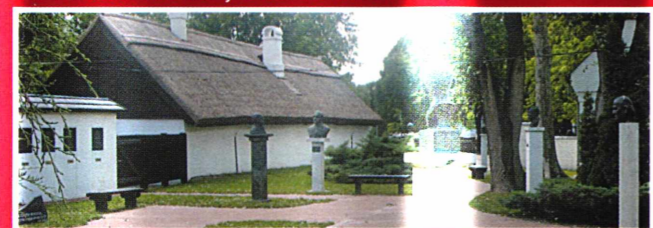


The statues of Jókai Mór, General Bem and Kossuth Lajos are on the Petőfi Square.

The typical Great Hungarian Plain peasant cottage preserves the period Slovak culture. The blue colour that has been used all over in the cottage for painting the windows, the doors and other furnishings is the „tótkék”. This colour is a quite peculiarity of the Slovakian traditional colouring. At that time nearly every house has this well insulating thatched roof.



This particular Slovakian traditional costume is still being worn nowadays on special events and celebrations. Several of the older generation wear these costumes as casual clothes.



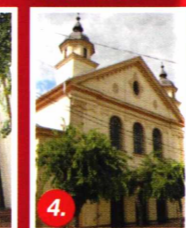

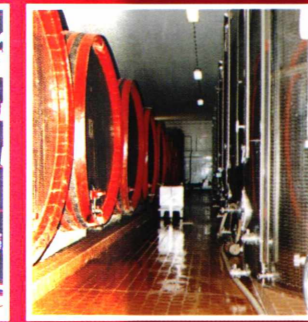


The exhibition room of Kiskőrös wine. The opportunity of local wine-tasting and purchasing cannot be missed here.

The Calvinist Chapel on the Tomori Street.

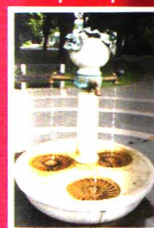


The new processing and ageing cellars operate on modern, gentler technological principles, meeting the highest European quality standards.
